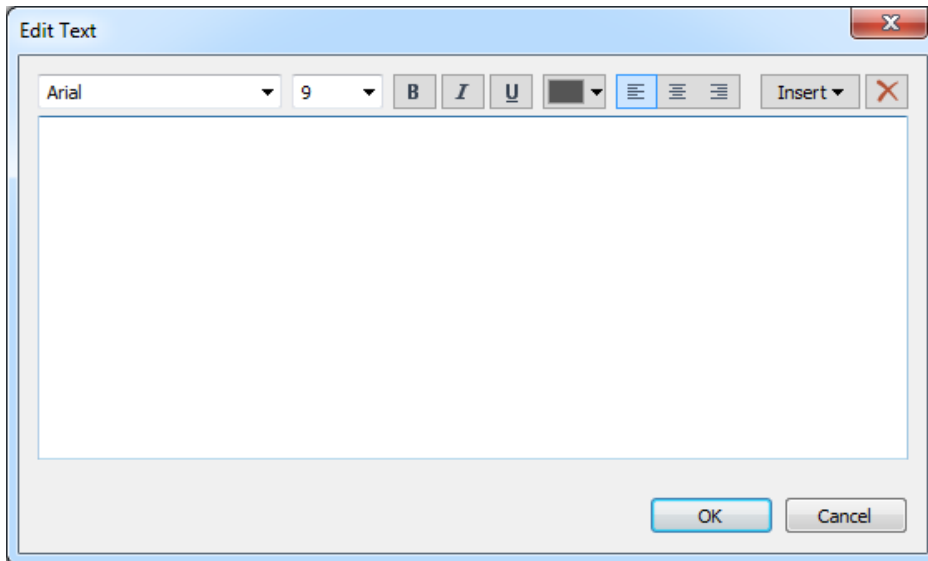


# Justify text

I would love to have the ability to "justify" (MS Word) or "align full" (this tool). Typically, when we need to add text to a viz, it's a pdf handout for administration. The text is necessary to explain the finer details of the data. It would be nice to hand out a more professional looking document. While it's great that the text is responsive to changes in the size of the text box, I spend a lot of time trying to get the end of the lines to be close to equal and also not have a "-" on every ending of a line.

We often put some context on our visualizations and the text tools offered currently are pretty minimal (left, center, right):

### Domestic Fall Headcounts by Residency

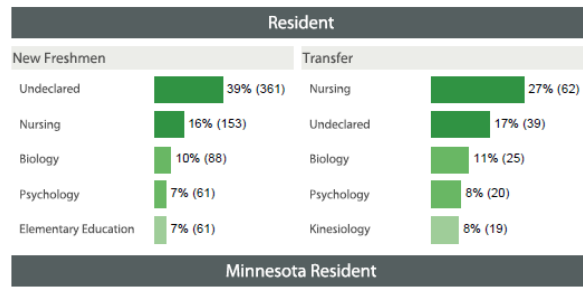
Resident	7,956	75%

Non-Resident	321	3%

This is a brief comparison of UW-Eau Claire students, based on residency. Initial major, incoming profile, and retention and graduation rates are examined for each of the three groups of students (Wisconsin residents, Minnesota residents, and all other non-residents).

One out of every four students at UW-Eau Claire is a non-resident. However, seven out of every eight non-resident students is from Minnesota. Non-resident students from other states only comprise three percent of UW-Eau Claire's total domestic enrollment.

The information on the right side of the page provides a comparison between the initial majors selected by Wisconsin residents and those of Minnesota and other non-
